TEBS was founded in 2002 under the direction of Dr. Derek Hunt, who serves as President.

Incorporation

Trinity Evangelical Bible Seminary is a non-profit religious corporation chartered by the State of Texas and has been granted tax-exempt status by the Texas State Comptroller of Public Accounts and by the Internal Revenue Service as a 501(c)(3) organization.

ACCREDITATION

TEBS is authorized to grant degrees by the State of Texas and is in compliance with Texas Statutes pursuant to religious institutions.

Reason why we are not pursuing national accreditation

(1) to keep our expenses low, enabling TEBS to maintain its very low tuition rates – pursuit of accreditation would require a dramatic increase in costs passed on to the student and when a student is completed the student will not have any loans to payback therefore the student will be free to work in ministry; (2) to maintain doctrinal autonomy, and (3) to continue the utilization of TEBS educated faculty to ensure theological and philosophical consistency with the doctrinal statement and mission of TEBS. Pursuit of accreditation would make this increasingly difficult.

Therefore, TEBS is an institution that is not under the jurisdiction or purview of the commission on independent education, is not required to obtain licensure, and does not operate under governmental oversight. The degree programs of TEBS are designed solely for religious purposes.

Because of the high standards set by TEBS administration and faculty, we are poised to be considered “accredited” and will always maintain a high level of education.

Graduate Level Programs

Masters Level Admission Process

Admission to the masters level degree program area requires that students have earned an undergraduate degree with a major or minor in a related field. Students who have an undergraduate in a non-related field must take core prerequisites before entering the masters level program.

If a student has earned an undergraduate degree from BTTI Seminary . No new application is necessary. Those students should contact our Business office and inform them they will be enrolling in our graduate program. Students who have earned an undergraduate degree from another institution of higher learning must complete an application and send in the appropriate fees. Students must also order an official transcript from the institution that granted them their undergraduate degree before full admission is granted into graduate program.

Doctoral Degree Level Admission Process

The Doctoral Degrees are the culmination of Seminary studies. The Doctoral Degree is a professional degree, specifically designed to equip the prospective student in the areas of Pastoral, Evangelistic, Missiology, and Seminary teaching ministry. Historically, in Europe, the doctorate degree was given primarily to men who were educators in the universities, or in the churches. These early doctorates were based predominantly upon the completion of studies by these men, while they were engaged in their respective vocations. These men would complete their studies under one or two professors or qualified individuals working under the auspices of the university. Upon entering a doctorate program, the student would either choose or be assigned a faculty advisor who would oversee his reading, research, and writing projects. Most of these courses were completed by independent study. Having completed his courses of study, the student would be given orator written examinations for evaluating his knowledge of the subject matter covered in the courses of study assigned to him. Upon satisfactory examination, the student would then proceed to write his dissertational project. Once the dissertation had been completed, the student would then submit the project to his advisor and the university. The student would then be assigned an appointed time at which he would give an oral defense of the doctoral dissertation. Upon acceptance of the completed project and defense, the student would be awarded the distinct honor of Doctor. These same practices are to a lesser degree still being carried on in the European schools today. The doctoral programs of TEB Seminary have been designed generally upon the structure and format of the European system. Each degree offers the flexibility to accommodate the needs of individual students, without compromising academic standards.
